

COMMUNITY NOTICE Coquitlam

Park and Ride Expansion for Coquitlam Central Station

Coquitlam Central Station located within the Coquitlam Central Transit Exchange is now almost complete, and Evergreen crews will start construction of a new Park and Ride lot east of the station along Aberdeen Avenue. This work will take place from July to October 2016. The work will also include improvements to Aberdeen Avenue west of Rona Home Centre and widening the right-turn lane from northbound Lansdowne Drive to eastbound Barnet Highway.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Construction will take place Monday Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Some night work may be required.
- Work will start around July 8th with utility and roadway work on Aberdeen Avenue and Lansdowne Drive, and building demolition, excavation and grading within the new Park and Ride site west of Rona. Installation of lighting, landscaping and a walkway to the station will take place later this summer.
- Nearby businesses may experience minor traffic delays on Aberdeen Avenue and Lansdowne
 Drive and noise related to construction activities, including the use of heavy machinery and backup beepers which are required for safety.
- Access to businesses will be maintained during utility and roadway work.
- Please watch for temporary street parking restrictions on Aberdeen Avenue west of Rona.
- Please drive with caution during this work and obey directions from traffic control personnel.

This is the final stage of construction in the area and we appreciate your patience during construction.
