




STATION UPDATES

Burquitlam Station

Burquitlam Station is a central focus of Coquitlam’s vision of a transit-oriented village for the area. The station is adjacent to Burquitlam Plaza on the east side of Clarke Road between Smith and Como Lake avenues, and will serve the 6,000 existing residents of the area, as well as the many new residents as the area redevelops.

Burquitlam Station is designed to complement and support the transit-oriented character envisioned for the area. The Evergreen Line Project is working with the city to incorporate the local area plan features into the station area, creating an integrated neighbourhood feel. The City of Coquitlam is building new sidewalks on either side of the station to improve access to the station. The station is bright and open with high ceilings. The use of glass at the station entrance and for elevator areas will create a safe environment, as passengers will be visible.

The open, pedestrian-friendly sidewalks and station entry area will allow easy connection for those walking to the station or transferring to and from buses at the station. There will be on-street bus stops in front of the station, and a new bus loop behind the station. Burquitlam Station will serve as a major connection point for buses travelling to and from Simon Fraser University.

Burquitlam Station will have passenger pick-up and drop-off spaces adjacent to the station, as well as a dedicated spot for a HandyDART service in front of the station. There will not be a Park and Ride at this station. For the convenience of cyclists, there will be bike racks and bike lockers next to the station. A new traffic signal north of the station area will allow pedestrians and cars to move easily in and out of the Burquitlam Plaza area.

What is the Evergreen Line?

The Evergreen Line project is an 11-kilometre extension to the existing SkyTrain system in Metro Vancouver. It will be a fast, frequent and convenient SkyTrain service, connecting Coquitlam City Centre through Port Moody to Lougheed Town Centre in approximately 15 minutes. It will connect without transfer to the current SkyTrain network at Lougheed Town Centre Station and will integrate with regional bus and West Coast Express networks. When the line opens, Metro Vancouver's SkyTrain system will become the longest fully automated rapid transit system in the world.
